Heard learned counsel for the parties on the application for
suspension of sentence.

Revision petition has been admitted after hearing both the parties at length by a detailed order and it is not likely to come up for hearing in near future. The revision petition involves certain questions of law for determination and, therefore, I consider it just and proper to suspend the substantive sentence of imprisonment awarded to the accused petitioner.

Accordingly, the bail application filed under Sec. 397(1) Cr.P.C. is allowed and it is ordered that the substantive sentence passed by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jodhpur in Cr.Case No.206/1999 and affirmed by the learned Sessions Judge, Jodhpur in Criminal Appeal No.50/2006 against petitioner Salman Khan s/o Salim Khan shall remain suspended till final disposal of the aforesaid revision provided he executes a personal bond in a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with two sureties of Rs.50,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for his appearance before this court on 24.10.2007 and whenever ordered to do so with the incorporation in the bond that as and when he will shift his place of residence, he will intimate to this Court and his lawyer about his new place of residence and shall not leave the country without prior permission of this Court.
