Chhattisgarh Assembly Elections 2008 - Phase 2 Candidate Criminal and Financial Record Chhattisgarh Election Watch(CGEW) 2008

In the phase 2 of Chhattisgarh Assembly elections, 51 Assembly constituencies out of 90 are going to the polls on Nov 20, 2008. CGEW has looked into affidavits filed by 524 candidates contesting elections in phase 2. Several facts have come out from compiling this information which are of wider public interest.

I: There are 42 candidates who have declared assets of over Rs.1 crores – of these maximum 19 are from Congress, 7 from the BJP and 5 from BSP. In spite of them being crorepatis, several of them have not given their PAN number.

In second phase also, as many as 218 candidates have declared that they own no vehicle. This list includes 27 candidates who are either crorepati or have declared assets for more than 25 lakh.

There are 29 candidates who have declared zero cash as well as zero deposit. This list includes 8 candidate whose asset value otherwise is more than ten lakhs and it also include 14 candidates who have declared that they have zero total assets, i.e they have no other assets in addition to not having any cash or any other deposits.

CGEW has found a total of 41 sitting MLAs contesting elections in phase 2. Although a few of them show that their net asset value has decreased, most have shown a huge increase in their assets from 2003 to 2008. For the MLAs whose assets have increased, the average increase per MLA has been 213% or almost 65 lakhs per MLA. The details for all these candidates are attached to this note.

II: A total of only 47 women are contesting elections in the second phase. Amongst the main parties, BJP has fielded only 2, INC 3, BSP 5, and others 37. Though major parties have given a public assurance to field 33% women candidates, they have not done so. The total percentage of women contesting elections is less than 9%

III: There are 53 candidates with pending criminal cases against them contesting Chhattisgarh Phase II elections. Among the major parties, the BSP has 8 candidates having a criminal record, BJP has 7, Congress has 7, SHS has 6, while Independents and others have 23.

Some of these candidates are charged with serious crimes. Party wise breakup of the candidates with criminal cases is as follows:

There were 12.5% criminal candidates contesting for elections in 2003 assembly elections (71 out of 567 for all constituencies) which is 10% for the phase II. This shows a slight reduction in the candidates with criminal records contesting elections.

IV: Several candidates including from the major parties have not declared their PAN numbers even though the affidavits have an option for giving the PAN Card number. Of the candidates not giving their PAN card no, BSP has 33 such candidates, BJP has 20, INC 17 and others include 308 such candidates. Several of the candidates not giving PAN no have assets in the excess of 1 crore.

V: CGEW is planning several efforts to disseminate this information to general public. Amongst these, there is a SMS campaign planned, where people will receive free alerts on:

- Candidate's financial background
- candidate's criminal background
- information on parties

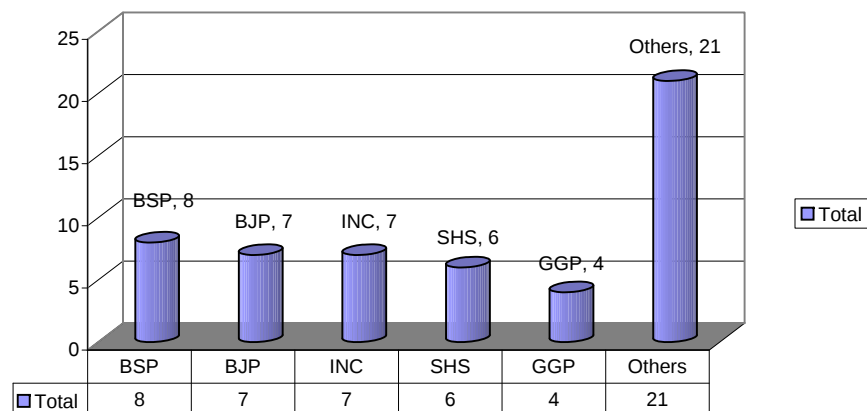
About ADR

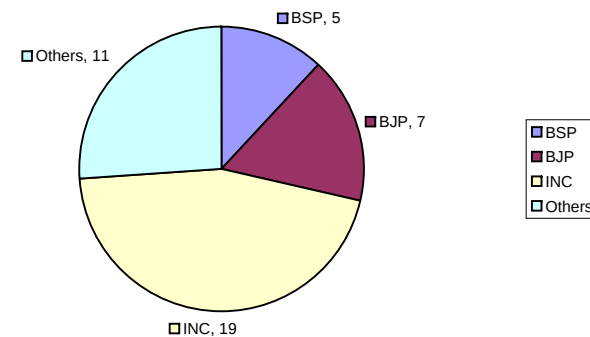

Chhattisgarh Phase 2 - Party wise snapshot (related to criminal cases, financial background and other parameters)

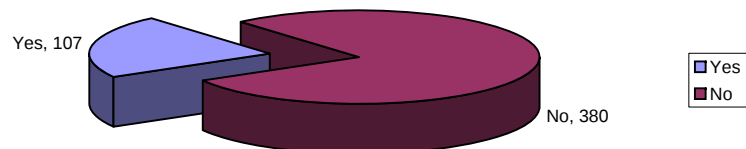
Candidates with criminal cases - party wise



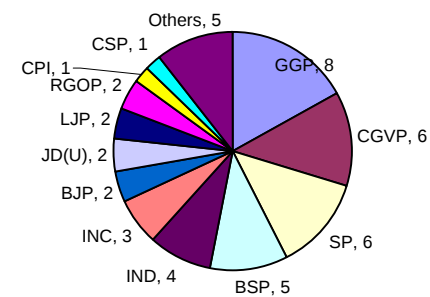
Crorepati Candidates Party Wise
