Sir,

With reference to your above mentioned RTI application which had been forwarded by Central Information Commission vide its letter No. CIC/AT/C/2009/000604 dated 22.9.2010 with following directions :-

- (i) In case no reply has been given by CPIO to the complainant to her RTI-request dated 7.7.2009, CPIO should furnish a reply to the complainant within two week of receipt of this order.
- (ii) In case CPIO has already given a reply to the complainant in the matter, he should furnish a copy of his reply to the complainant within one week of receipt of this order.
- (iii) CPIO should invariably indicate to the complainant the name and address of the 1st Appellate Authority, before whom the complainant can file first-appeal, if any.
- (iv) A copy of CPIO's reply should also be endorsed to the Commission.

Therefore, in response to the directions of the CIC, I would like to inform you that the Bar Council of India at its meeting held on 12th and 13th September, 2009 has considered this matter and took the following decision :-

"It is clarified that person who is having below 45% marks at the Graduation Level but having 45% or more than 45% marks in Post Graduation level is eligible to take admission in three year law course, if he is otherwise qualified as per the rules of the Bar Council of India.

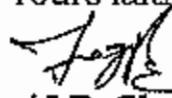
In view of the above, if any candidate wants to take admission in LL.B course, he can take either on the base of graduation or post graduation subject to the minimum percentage as prescribed by Bar Council of India under Rule of Legal Education, 2008.

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Therefore, in view of the above if a applicant is having 45% and above in post-graduation level will be eligible to take admission in 3 year law courses if he is otherwise qualified as per the rules of the Bar Council of India.

Mr. Milan Kumar Dey, Sr. Advocate, Chairman, Executive Committee, Bar Council of India, 21, Rouse Avenue, Institutional Area, New Delhi - 110002 is the First Appellate Authority. The period for filing appeal is 30 days from receipt of this letter.
