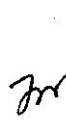
Dear Members:

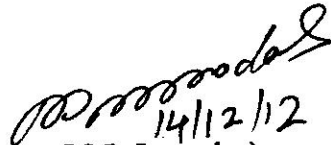
Hon'ble the Chief Justice of India has been pleased to direct as hereunder:-

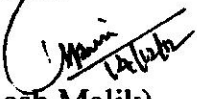

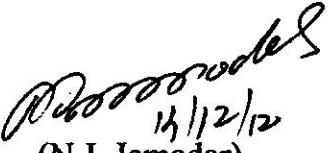

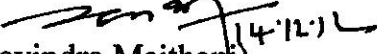
In order to further streamline the procedure, Hon'ble the Chief Justice of India has been pleased to direct as hereunder: -
