Getting Many queries Regarding validity of mobile apps as per Indian law. Clarifying here on some Most popular Legal Issues of mobile apps.

What Is mobile Application:-

A mobile application is a software application developed specifically for use on small, wireless computing devices, such as smart phones and tablets, rather than desktop or laptop computers. But way of services same as websites. So Indian laws applies in same way what ever applicable to websites/softwares via online mode.

Way of service:-

Examples:- gambling, prostitution Etc...

## Jurisdiction of cyber law in India:-

Under Section 1 and Section 75 of Indian Penal Code, it has been mentioned that there is no jurisdiction for a cyber crime. Mobile applications are also under Indian cyber law

## Offense and Penalty :-

### THE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY ACT, 2000

67. Publishing of information which is obscene in electronic form.

Whoever publishes or transmits or causes to be published in the electronic form, any material which is lascivious or appeals to the prurient interest or if its effect is such as to tend to deprave and corrupt persons who are likely, having regard to all relevant circumstances, to read, see or hear the matter contained or embodied in it, shall be punished on first conviction with imprisonment of either description for a term which may extend to five years and with fine which may extend to one lakh rupees and in the event of a second or subsequent conviction with imprisonment of either description for a term which may extend to ten years and also with fine which may extend to two lakh rupees
