Shri Neeraj Kumar Sharma (ICAS:2004) vide application dated 19.10.2011 had represented regarding assigning inter-se seniority in ICAS on the basis of Civil Services Examination – 2003.

2. Three officers viz. Shri Subhas Chandra (OBC Category; Rank No.350), Shri Yogesh Kumar Meena (ST Category; Rank No.408) including Shri Neeraj Kumar Sharma (General Category; Rank No.426) whose name was appeared in supplementary list were allocated ICAS on the basis of the result of Civil Services Examination – 2003. Their seniority as a result was fixed on the basis of rank allotted by DoPT. It being the fact that Shri Neeraj Kumar Sharma vide his representation has mentioned that despite of his securing more marks in the same examination, his name has been placed below the name of other two above referred officers in the Departmental Seniority List.

3. The matter was taken up with UPSC and DoPT respectively for clarification. Now DoPT vide their OM No. 22012/15/2013-AIS (I) dated 09.01.2014 have directed to Cadre Controlling Authorities(CCAs) concern to assign inter-se-seniority of the candidates allocated to a particular service on the basis of the aggregate marks obtained by the candidates in the Civil Service Examination.

4. In pursuance of the DoPT's above mentioned OM the inter-se-seniority in respect of the following ICAS officers have been re-assigned on the basis of marks obtained in Civil Service Examination – 2003 as mentioned against each of them:

The undersigned is directed to refer to the subject cited above and to say that the issue of fixation of rank to the candidates allocated service on the basis of CSE main list and reserve list has been examined in consultation with the Establishment Division of this Department and UPSC.

2. It is informed that the CCAs may like to assign inter-se-seniority of the candidates recommended on the basis of a particular service through the Civil services Examination and also allocated to a particular service, on the basis of the aggregate marks obtained by the candidate. The merits of the candidates for determining inter-se-seniority may be determined based on the aggregate marks of the candidates revealed by the UPSC. In case of the tie incidents (equal marks), the UPSC may be consulted directly to resolve the issue.

3. The statement of marks of the candidates may be sought from the UPSC.

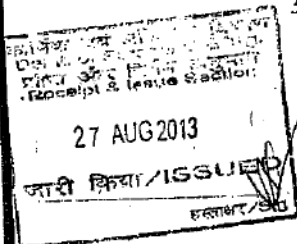

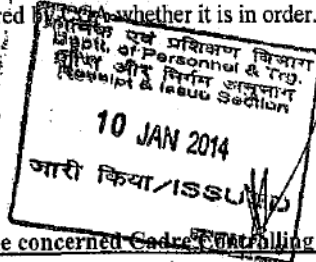

This Department, after consultation with UPSC and the Establishment Division of this Department had already issued necessary direction to the CCAs concerned to assign inter-se-seniority of the candidates allocated to a particular service on the basis of the aggregate marks obtained by the candidates in Civil Service Examination. It is sole discretion of the Department/Ministry, as a CCA for the service to determine inter-se-seniority on the basis of aggregate marks of the candidates revealed by the UPSC. This Department has no comment to offer on the issue of seniority list prepared by UPSC whether it is in order.

**DRAFT SENIORITY ROLL OF SENIOR SCIENTIFIC OFFICERS GRADE-II IN
DGAQA ORGANISATION IN COMPLIANCE OF ORDER DATED 19.09.2017
PASSED BY HON'BLE CAT, BANGALORE BENCH IN O.A.
No.170/00971/2016 – SMT. UMESH KUWAR Vs UOI & ORS.**

1. Reference this HQrs letters F. No. 2927/SSO-II/DGAQA/Admin-I dated 26 Nov 2015 and 13 Oct 2016.

2. The draft seniority roll of officers in the grade of Senior Scientific Officer Grade-II in DGAQA organisation issued vide above referred letter dated 26 Nov 2015 was challenged by Smt. Umesh Kuwar, SSO-II before Hon'ble CAT, Bangalore Bench by filing O.A. No. 170/00971/2016.

3. With respect to the facts of the above mentioned case, the CAT, Bangalore Bench in its Order dated 19.09.2017 has, *inter alia*, issued the following directions:-

"..... In the light of the discussions, we hold that the placement of the applicant at the bottom of the consolidated seniority list is not in consistence with the DoPT O.M. dated 3.7.1986 and therefore, the communication dated 13.10.2016 at Annexure-A19 is set aside. The applicant shall be placed in terms of marks secured by her vis-à-vis other selected candidates of that particular year. Further in regard to the inter-se seniority between all candidates selected in the six disciplines in the consolidated merit list the same should be prepared by the respondents based strictly on the marks secured by them as communicated by UPSC. The inter-se seniority between promotees and direct recruits shall be re-examined treating the vacancy year for direct recruits as 2008-09. The respondents are therefore, directed to prepare the seniority list afresh in accordance with the observations and directions given above. The draft seniority list shall be prepared within a period of four (4) months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and then finalised after giving an opportunity for representation, if any, to the draft seniority list....."

4. With respect of the above Order dated 19.09.2017 of Hon'ble CAT, DoP&T has, *inter alia*, observed that pursuant to the Supreme Court judgement dated 27/11/2012 in Civil Appeal No. 7514-7515/2005 in the case of N.R. Parmar Vs Uoi, DoP&T had issued O.M. dated 04.03.2014 for fixation of inter-se seniority between direct recruit and promotee officers. In this O.M., it has been clearly specified that the earlier

principles of fixation of inter-se seniority as mentioned in O.M. dated 3.7.1986 shall continue to be operated. However, as per the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court, the concept of "Recruitment Year" has been introduced in this O.M. which is defined as per the year of initiating of the recruitment process against a vacancy year. It is further specified in this O.M. that initiation of recruitment process for any of the modes viz. direct recruitment or promotion would be deemed to be the initiation of recruitment process for the other modes as well.

5. In light of the above facts, DoP&T stated that the observations of Hon'ble CAT seem logical and may be implemented. M/o Law & Justice, Office of LA(Def) were also consulted which opined that the directions passed by the Hon'ble CAT are unambiguous and the same may be considered by the Deptt. in terms of the comments rendered by DoP&T.

6. IT may also be noted that in this draft seniority roll, individuals indicated at Sl No. 1 to 30 (except Sl 17, 21 & 29) have already been promoted to the grade of Senior Scientific Officer Grade-I. The names of these officers have been reflected only for the purpose of maintaining seniority as direction passed by the Hon'ble CAT. The names of those officer who have been appointed against Recruitment year 2014-15 and onwards have not been reflected.

7. Accordingly, draft seniority roll of officers in the grade of Senior Scientific Officer Grade-II in DGAQA organisation prepared in compliance of directions of Hon'ble Tribunal in Order dated 19.09.2017 is at **Annexure-1**. This draft seniority roll may be downloaded from DGAQA website (www.dgaeroqa.gov.in).

8. It is requested that the draft seniority roll may be circulated amongst all concerned officers of your establishments who should check their particulars indicated against their name for accuracy and intimate discrepancy, if any.

9. If any addition in Educational Qualification is required to be made, a copy of the DO Part-II Order may be forwarded alongwith the certificate of possessing the said educational qualification by the concerned officer.

10. All Heads of the FEs/Units are also requested to check particulars of their concerned officers from the service book/records maintained by them and confirm correctness of the particulars.

11. The requisite inputs and representation(s) from concerned officer(s), if any, shall be forwarded through proper channel so as to reach this HQrs latest by **23 February, 2018** failing which it will be construed that there is no representation against the draft seniority and the same will be treated as final.
